Within each of the houses the pupils are organizing their own charity projects which link to their Saint. This is a short description of their current projects:

St Bernadette house are having a competition to grow sunflowers throughout the summer term. They will work with families and the school community to plant and look after the flowers. They are also organizing to set up a foodbank collection point in school that we will take to the Coalville foodbank on a regular basis. The children plan to make leaflets to send home to parents making them aware of the types of items that will be collected and parents can then give as and when they can.

St Francis house have a recycling theme to their project and are supporting the air ambulance. Their clothes container is beside the grotto and we hope everyone will contribute to it. All money raised from the clothes deposited goes directly to the air ambulance charity. If the gates are closed just pop your donation over and the house captains will ensure that everything is deposited.

Joan of Arc house have elected to support the "make a Wish," foundation and are currently running the Penny Challenge. Each house has been given their own "pig" collection tub, as well as the staff and children are encouraged to bring in their pennies. There will be a prize for the winning house.

St Christopher house are supporting the plight of refugees and have made contact with the Red Cross who have agreed to come out and speak to the children during an assembly. They will then be having a toy collection which they hope to give to the Sacred Heart church appeal in Leicester.
